Documents Page Menu Change For Your Convenience:

The left-hand menu, if you haven't visited very recently, has an additional item that makes it easy to go directly to the photo folders.

New Photo Folder added:

The new photo folder is a "virtual cemetery": A place where photos of gravestones should be placed. It is not intended to be morbid. Rather, this folder is intended to be a memorial to our honored, departed relatives, as well as an archive, because gravestones (especially those that are older) can be significant sources of genealogical information.

In addition, it appears that, as we get further from these ancestors in time, many descendents often do not even recall where the remains of their ancestors are. The virtual cemetery will record that information. At some point, a complete directory of "who is where" will be provided online, along with directions to the actual cemeteries.

New "Virtual Art Gallery"

Another new photo folder is a "virtual art gallery" that is dedicated to the fine, creative and performing artists in our families. This is just starting, with photos of a few works of Paul Chaleff, Brynn Olenberg Sugarman and others. Our relatively small family has more than its share of talent, and it is hoped that this galley will be a vibrant part of the family website.

Please remember that it should not be considered to be important for the art to be the artist's primary occupation, in order for inclusion in the gallery. We have numerous talented family members who made, or make, a living in a field

that is completely unrelated to their art. That doesn't/didn't make them any less talented!
